

EXHIBITORS CONDITIONS OF EXHIBITING

1. INTRODUCTION AND GENERAL INFORMATION

We look forward to once again having you display your amazing creations at Bricktober Perth (a project of the Ascot Rotary Club). The funds raised from this event go to:

- Providing LEGO® in the form of Playtubs for new and existing LEGO® Play Groups.
- Supporting a variety of local community programmes including, but not limited to providing scholarships for young people to attend Rotary run leadership camps, donations to schools, and supporting local charities and worthwhile causes. The causes we support will change annually depending on need and interest.
- Funding to Rotary Foundation to support their humanitarian programmes internationally. Currently we have been directing these funds to end Polio worldwide.

As we need to ensure that all concerned with the event are well informed, we need a framework that everyone abides by to ensure a successful and safe event.

The minimum age for adult exhibitors is 16 years of age at the time of the show. Displays built by a person under 16, will be accepted into the Junior Builders category. Details for the Junior Builders will be released in mid-August.

Be aware there may not be gaps between display tables so please consider that if you build right to the edge of your allocated space you could meld into your neighbour's display. All tables have open backs, and none are against walls. You can provide your own backing board which should only be at shoulder height.

Keep in mind that publicising photos/videos of your exhibits on social media before the show reduces the surprise of your model being revealed at the event.

A couple of weeks prior to Bricktober Perth you will receive an information pack regarding bump-in and out and all other information related to the event.

There will be a briefing session at a "Welcome Event" for all Exhibitors to attend on the Friday night at 6.30 pm. At that time, you will receive your gratuities pack. We anticipate that you will have set up your display by 6.15 pm.

If you wish to make an official request, such as you want to change your table request, theme, assistant name, etc. you need to do it via email. This is the only official format for such communication to be received by us to act upon requests and queries. We cannot guarantee a request made via another platform will be acted upon. 2. CONDITIONS OF EXHIBITING (APPLICATIONS CLOSE 4 AUGUST 2023)

- Bricktober Perth values are based on the event being family friendly, so we ask you to ensure that your exhibit is appropriate for this event. If in doubt, ask.
- You agree not to speak to the media on behalf of Bricktober-Perth, unless authorized to do so.
- You agree never to be under the influence of any alcohol or drugs whilst at the Bricktober Perth event and refrain from smoking as Curtin University Campus is a smoke free zone.
- You agree to sign in and out each day as you enter and exit.
- You agree not to touch or interfere with the displays of other Exhibitors.
- You agree to follow any reasonable instruction given by the event Operations Manager during the weekend.
- As the exhibitor, you are responsible for the care and supervision of your assistant/s at all times.
- Displays should have someone manning them throughout the open times of the show. Should you and your assistant/s need to leave your display for any reason, please ask a nearby exhibitor to watch your display while you are absent.
- A photographer representing Bricktober Perth will be taking photographs and videos at this event for promotional purposes. If you do not wish to be photographed or filmed at the event, please advise the photographer or camera person.
- You agree and allow that the names of you as an exhibitor and that of your assistant/s, plus, photographs/videos taken at the event by the Bricktober Perth photographer may be used in social media platforms, newspaper advertisements, TV commercials and other promotional material to promote the current and/or future Bricktober events.
- You agree to wear your Bricktober Perth Exhibitor polo shirt or t-shirt during the event.
- For safety reasons shoes must be worn at all times (no thongs).
- You agree to take reasonable care of your own health and safety, as well as the health and safety of those around you.
- Any risks to health and safety, emergencies, queries, concerns or grievances to be reported to the event Operations Manager immediately.
- You agree that if you need power for your display, you will bring your own cord/s and they will have been tested and have a current tag on them. There will be no testing and tagging available at the event. This is not only a condition of Bricktober but also Curtin Stadium.
- You acknowledge that as an exhibitor you are representing Bricktober Perth and must do so in a positive, non-prejudicial manner or behaviour that will not negatively affect the experience, safety or well-being of all patrons. This includes when using all social networking sites.
- You agree that you have no convictions, spent or otherwise and no outstanding warrants or charges pending against you that would exclude you from exhibiting at the event.
- By applying to exhibit at Bricktober Perth you agree to abide by all the terms and conditions outlined and any breaches will be dealt with promptly and you agree that any decisions will be final.
