



## **INFORMATION ABOUT THE LEGO® BRICK TUBS PROGRAMME**

The Ascot Rotary Club, through its Bricktober Project, wishes to assist with the setting up of LEGO<sup>®</sup> play groups in Western Australia by providing LEGO<sup>®</sup> supplies through our LEGO<sup>®</sup> Play Tubs initiative.

Setting up and running a LEGO<sup>®</sup> Club may seem daunting and a complicated task but it need not be. In its most basic form, it is an opportunity for children to get together and play with LEGO<sup>®</sup> whilst learning valuable life skills, developing social and motor skills, solving problems creatively and boosting confidence and resilience.

Once your application has been received it will be presented to the next Ascot Rotary Club Board Meeting (they meet monthly) for approval and a decision on how many tubs your organisation could receive. The outcome will be advised to you in due course.

As the tubs are purchased from the proceeds of our Bricktober event there may be a delay in receiving your play tub/s as it will depend upon what stock we have available at the time.

If your application is successful, it is a condition that your club will:

- display each year at our Bricktober event held during the last weekend of the school holidays in October
- give permission for the information regarding your organisation to be used in promotional material regarding the support you have received from Ascot Rotary Club Bricktober Project. This may include, but is not limited to, articles regarding your story, photos of the recipient(s) and details of the support received.
- promote Bricktober to your families and encourage them to come and see what their children have been buildings. We in turn will annually provide advertising material about Bricktober. This will assist us to continue to raise funds and be able to provide more LEGO<sup>®</sup> bricks for more Lego Play Clubs. This could be in your newsletters, on our social pages or through an email database. Please provide a direct contact for this purpose:
